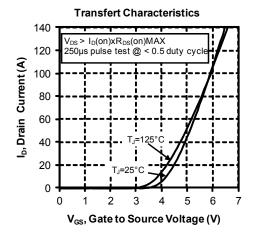


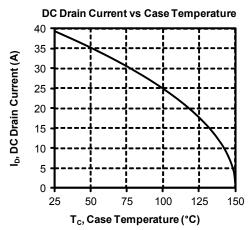
### **Typical CoolMOS Performance Curve**









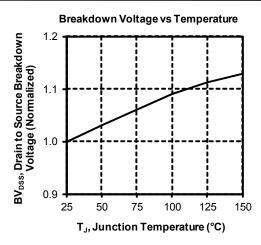


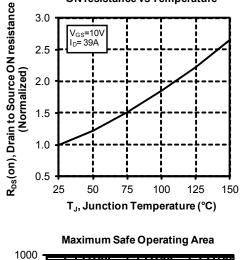
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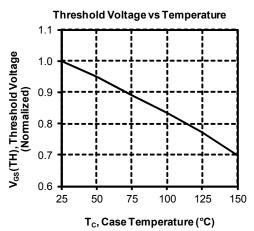


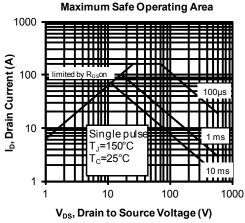

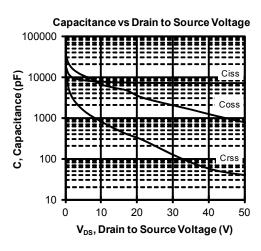
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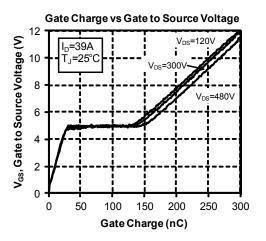




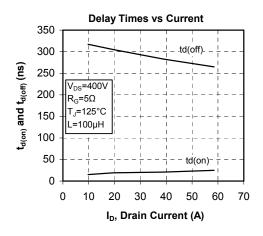


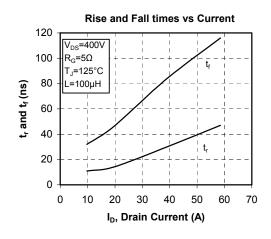


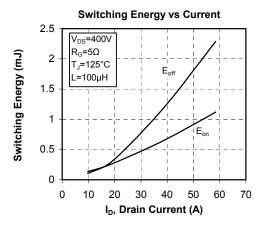


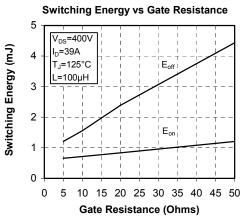


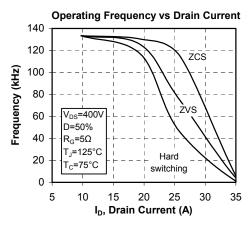


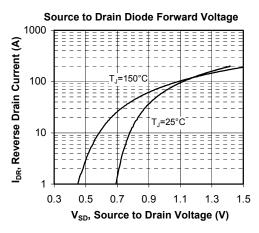






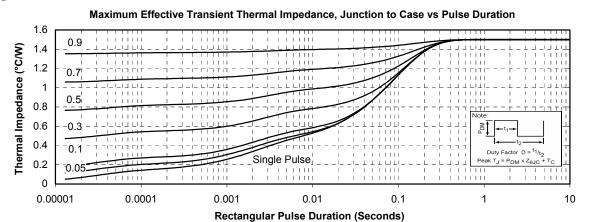


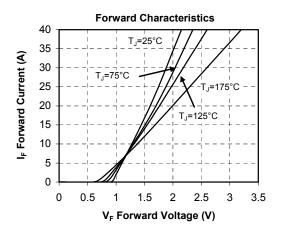


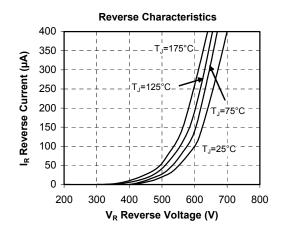


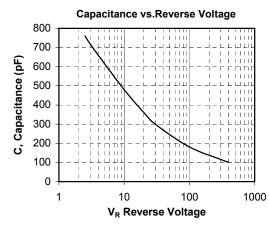


### **Typical SiC Diode Performance Curve**
